Year 1 have been super scientists exploring different groups of animals such as mammals, birds, reptiles, fish and amphibians. We are hoping to visit the Rare Breeds Centre later this term to find out more (please look out for a letter next week). We are also very excited to have an incubator and eggs in class. We will keep you updated on them as the term goes on.
