Home learning ideas for the holidays

- Reading: Christmas cards and gift tags, toy labels and instructions, new books etc
- Writing: Christmas cards, thankyou cards, shopping lists
- Maths: count sweets, toys, brussel sprouts on your plate! Share out treats and toys in games, add scores and compare totals. Guess your presents by feeling the package, describe the shape and its features such as corners, curved or straight sides, face shapes etc. Talk about time; what is the time, how long until different events or when an event will start and finish.
- Curious Curriculum: make a weather diary to see how the weather has changed. Use a thermometer to read and record the temperature outside.
- RE: relate Christmas to the Nativity story
- PSED: discuss why Christmas is important to us such as giving, sharing and family. Share or create new family traditions together
